The Eudora Schools Professional Development Council will provide the first-level review of the applications, with final decisions made by the Academic Team and building principals. The PDC will focus feedback on the applications using a scale of 1 to 4 (1 = insufficient evidence to 4 = strong evidence), in the following areas:

Impact = The workshop or conference has the ability to transform or transcend practices to improve student achievement and/or experiences.

Longevity = The workshop or conference has the ability to make a lasting impact over a period of time on the practices and/or culture within the classroom, building, or district.

Execution = The proposal provides a clear and detailed plan of implementation to proceed from the knowledge, application, and impact levels of professional development.

Budget = The proposal provides a detailed report of anticipated expenditures to include registration, travel, and implementation.

Thank you for all you do for Eudora students. Applications are due Friday, October 18, at 5:00 pm. The PDC intends to review applications and make recommendations to our Academic Team and building principals on October 23, 2019. With feedback from our PDC and Academic Team, decisions will be made regarding scholarship awards shortly after. Announcements of award winners will take place in November.
